Candace Dwan Gallery, Katonah is pleased to announce the first solo exhibition in the United States of photographs by the Finnish photographer Kristoffer Albrecht.

Albrecht, who lives in Helsinki, and shares a studio with another Dwan Gallery favorite Pentti Sammallahti (currently on exhibit at the West 57th St location) has had many solo exhibitions in his native land and also internationally. Known for his quiet, thoughtful, contemplative images and his ability to make the invisible visible, his work will appeal to anyone who enjoys the simple pleasures of everyday objects.

“I am interested in found objects or situations and in the beauty of small details. Though it may seem a cliché this is what I do, I strive to see the small details that we so often overlook. A glass, a spoon, a stone, these all appeal to me. In this way my work is based on observation rather than on construction,” says the photographer.

Albrecht’s work is intimate, honest and quietly beautiful. His imagery invites us into a private, timeless world where things are simple and serene. Through his eyes we can enjoy the beauty of a barbed wire fence cutting through a field of snow or the elegant simplicity of a bow on a piece of fabric. In the same way the woman gently offers us a handful of fresh apples in *Small Apples*, Albrecht gently offers us his photographs - his meditations on the hidden world of the small detail.
